The Mallee Family Violence Executive (MFVE) is seeking a MARAM Capability Coordinator to lead and strengthen MARAM and Information Sharing alignment across the Mallee region. This is a newly created, 12-month position offering a unique opportunity to influence practice, build capability, and support meaningful, sector-wide change.

While employment is with Mallee Sexual Assault Unit – Mallee Domestic Violence Service as the auspice agency, the role sits within the Mallee Family Violence Executive team and is supported by the Principal Strategic Advisor.

About the Role

The MARAM Capability Coordinator works closely with MFVE member organisations and other relevant stakeholders to:

- Increase understanding of MARAM alignment
- Improve organisational buy-in and compliance with MARAM requirements
- Strengthen the embedding of MARAM within organisational systems, structures, policies, and practices

As part of the MARAMIS Sector Support Program, the role provides leadership and practical support to organisations across the Mallee region, ensuring consistent, high-quality implementation of MARAM and Information Sharing reforms.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead delivery of MARAM and Information Sharing alignment activities across the Mallee region
- Provide tailored capability-building support to MFVE member and other Mallee organisations
- Strengthen cross-sector understanding and collaboration in relation to MARAM
- Support organisations to embed MARAM within policies, procedures, governance, and practice frameworks
- Work collaboratively with the MFVE team, auspice agency, and regional stakeholders
- Contribute to regional planning, reporting, and continuous improvement activities
